Transitioning from an unstable housing situation to a more stable home for the first time can be strange and challenging. For many of the youth served at Outreach, this may be their first home and their first time having to consider what could help them as they move in. By completing this activity, your group will welcome youth into their new homes and provide the very first housewarming gift they've ever received.

WHAT ARE WE DOING?

Collect items from the list provided either by purchasing the items or having the items donated, and assemble the items into apartment kits. While the list should serve as a helpful guide, it is not necessary to collect all of the items on the list. Once the kits are assembled, your group should deliver the kits to the Outreach Program Center located at 2416 E New York Street.

WHERE ARE WE DOING IT?

After your group collects the items from the list provided, you can choose to assemble the apartment kits at a location that is convenient to you (your home, office, church, etc.), or you can choose to assemble the kits in our Program Center.

HOW MANY PEOPLE DO WE NEED?

There is no minimum or maximum group size for this activity. A good rule of thumb is to determine how many people you need based on the amount of kits you plan to assemble. In our experience, the larger the size of your group, the faster the kits are assembled.

ARE WE GOING TO HAVE FUN?

Yes! Every time you volunteer at Outreach, don't forget that what you are doing is truly helping the youth we serve. Always remind yourself and your group that you are doing something incredible. Take photos and videos of your work and your group to share on your social feeds, and be sure to tag Outreach in your posts!
